

There are about 10,000 children living with cancer in Canada today.

Each year, about 1500 cases are diagnosed.

There are about 40 different types of childhood cancer.

1 in 400 children will be diagnosed with cancer before their 19th birthday.

Cancer is rare in children, but it is the number one disease killer of our Canadian children.

Because of significant advances in therapy, 82% of these children will survive 5 years or more, an increase of about 50% since the early 1960s.

With a mortality rate of close to 20%, Canada loses tens of thousands of years of potential life each year to childhood cancer. In terms of potential life saved, childhood cancers rank second only to breast cancer.

Despite significant advances in the treatment of childhood cancers, and an 82% long-term survival rate, the long-term effects of surviving treatments for the cancers can affect these children's futures. Through the efforts of the CCF, we fight cancer through research, mentoring cancer patients, providing survivors with scholarships and education.
